

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



President Jack Bagley

Summer provides the opportunity for the our Juniors to demonstrate their hard work with their Belties in various Shows and Field Days in many parts of the country. Please continue to support their efforts.

The Council held a meeting in early June in conjunction with the

Great Lakes Belted Galloway Association's Field Day in Indiana. The Council had a full agenda, and accepted the recommendations of several Committees who had been assigned tasks in previous meetings.

The Budget and Finance Committee, under Chairman Terry Etheridge (WI), presented the results of its review on the Society's finances (current and future.) The costs allocated to the Society by CLRC for services continue to increase. Members have also been concerned with delays in processing transfers and other paperwork by CLRC.

The Committee learned that the current BGS membership fees are one of the lowest of all cattle breed associations, and fees have not been adjusted in over ten years. Thus, this combination of factors and a commitment by the Council to invest in new breed promotion, member outreach and Junior activities has resulted in a new fee structure that will take effect in 2023.

As a corollary to this review, the Council is undertaking a review of alternatives to the current contract with CLRC for

services. Tommy Fey (TX) is the Chairman of this effort. The results of this exercise will be available at the upcoming Annual Meeting.

The Council also considered a Report from Sheri Riley (TX), Chairman of the Advertising and Promotion Committee. The Council accepted the recommendation to retain Jayde Reilly (WI) to continue organizing the contents and publication of the Beltie Journal. Please support Jayde's efforts in this regard with advertising and feature articles. The Journal is an important piece of our Society's breed promotion and your participation is critical.

Dawson Masters (TX) gave an update on the ongoing conversations by the Show Committee with NAILE on the schedules at Louisville. The goal is to have the Belted Galloway Junior Show during the weekend to allow more Juniors to participate without missing too much school.

The Long Range Planning Committee under Don Henderson (NY) had no updates, but will have a Report at the Annual Meeting.

The last item on the agenda was a presentation by Corinna Caron on her goals and vision for the new position of Director of Breed Promotion and Member Outreach. The presentation is available on beltie.org. I encourage all members to view the presentation and support her efforts.

The Council is supporting Corinna's efforts to address many of the issues raised by the membership over the past few years.



The year code on tattoos for animals born in year **2022** is










