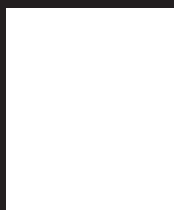

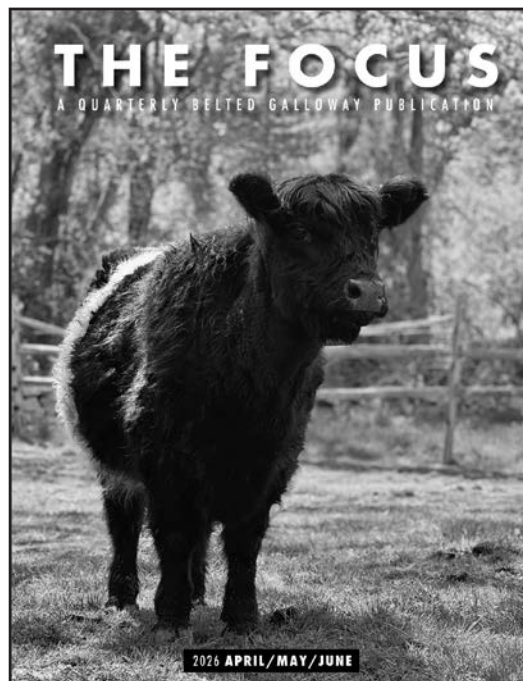

HYPOTRICHOSIS & DNA TESTING REQUIREMENTS

Reminder! All males born after January 1, 2018 must be DNA and HYPO tested in order to be registered. ALL ET calves must be DNA and HYPO tested in order to be registered. ALL donor cows must be DNA and HYPO tested to have qualifying embryos for registration. All testing requests are done at the start of the registration process in Digital Beef. If you would like to request a DNA and or HYPO test for an already registered animal please contact Stephanie at bgs.registrar@gmail.com

DID YOU KNOW?

If the lab has a hair sample on file from a DNA test you can request a HYPO test without having to send in a new sample* HYPO tests are \$30.

*Pending sufficient sample size is on file.

SPRING COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

April 15, 2026 7 PM ET
Zoom

Call to Order: President Voisine called the meeting to order at 7:06 pm EST

Roll Call - Present: Victoria Voisine (P), Terry Etheridge (VP), Marisa Craig (Treas), Emily Wilkerson, Elizabeth Eaton, Kim Lohmann, Karla Denton, Dana Jacobsen, Corinna Caron (ED) Absent: Sheri Riley, Erin Seal

Minutes February 11, 2026 - Minutes from the February 11 Council meeting were reviewed. Motion by Kim L to approve the minutes, seconded by Dana J. All in favor.

Committee Reports

Junior Association - NJBGA is still working to secure sponsorships for the 2026 Junior Nationals. We have had lots of new sponsors this year. The NJBGA is holding an informational Zoom meeting for Junior Nationals on April 16 at 8pm EST. Entry deadlines are May 1st and May 15th late fees applied.

Advertising and Promotion - This committee met March 23, 2026. Discussion focused around getting members involved more directly with advertising, and social media. The committee agreed that a new media kit should be created to send out to members and businesses that highlights the positives of advertising with the BGS. We also came up with a social media photo contest which was implemented and had almost 100 entries. The winner had their photo made into the FB cover photo and the top 10 will have their images in the June issue of The Focus. The committee meets again May 4.

Show Committee - This committee met March 25, 2026. Emily informed council that the committee's discussion focused on having a larger committee and council presence at point shows to help as needed. Things look good heading into show season.

Finance Committee - This committee met April 13, 2026. Corinna presented the committee a draft of the 2026 budget and went over the 2025 actuals. Committee

discussed areas that we could improve upon for income such as NAILE sponsorships and annual meeting income and areas of expenses to keep an eye on such as photos that are purchased for The Focus.

Old Business

Membership Renewal Update - We have 401 regular members so far for 2026, our 2025 total was 522. We have 79 junior members for 2026, our 2025 total was 108. There are 156 regular memberships that have yet to renew in 2026 from 2025 and 192 regular memberships from 2024 that have not renewed. We have 39 juniors that have not renewed from 2025 and 41 from 2024. *keep in mind some have aged out of junior status* So far in 2026 we have 27 new regular members and 12 new junior members.

Matching Donation Opportunity - This opportunity has been extended to April 25th. So far \$500 of sponsorships have been collected from current and past council members that will be matched. Please consider sponsoring if you are a past or present council member.

Bull Hypo Testing - Corinna reached out to UC Davis - we can use current samples on file for hypo testing - if a sample is not good enough or large enough then they would ask for more before testing. They can also use semen straws for testing for Hypo. Digital Beef pulled report for us - we currently have 784 animals (both males and females) that have DNA on file but no hypo results. That is higher than anticipated. Corinna will see if we can add the number of progeny from each of these animals to help determine order of potential importance. Genetic Testing Alternates - Emily contacted Zoetis about the opportunity to use their labs for testing as they offer different types of testing and at a potential decrease in cost. Zoetis is no longer accepting outside databases and Neogen has been sold to Zoetis so that eliminates that possibility. BGS will continue to use UC Davis.

2025 Taxes - Corinna signed the electronic forms today and our 2025 taxes have been filed.

New Business:

701x Update - There are changes coming to the registration software system we know as Digital Beef. The coding that Digital Beef was

based on is becoming obsolete and can not be updated so programmers with 701x are working on a software update with new coding and this will give the platform a new fresh look. It will no longer be called Digital Beef - it will be the breed's registry and called such (Belted Galloway Registry). Corinna will be attending a summit put on by 701x in May in North Dakota with other breed executive directors that use Digital Beef that will explain more of the transition, options and how this will be rolled out (tentatively in August)

Southeast Regional Chapter - Council is excited about a new regional group but they do have concerns about the word "Society" in the group's title. Corinna will reach out and have a conversation with them about using a different term so that we can help ensure lack of confusion between regional groups and national society.

2026 Budget Presentation - Corinna presented the financials for 2025 actuals and 2026 budget. We came in at -5244 for 2025 which was \$3000 better than budgeted. Our 2026 budget puts us at -\$19680. Discussion was had about income amounts and expense items. A motion was made by Terry to have the Executive Committee meet within the next 2 weeks to determine pricing for independent contractors. Seconded by Dana J, all in favor.

Other - Corinna informed Council that the "classification" view has been disabled for members, only admin can see an animal's classification. Corinna also informed Council that past due invoices (30 days plus) for things such as advertising etc will result in a lock of their Digital Beef account until invoice is paid.

Adjourn Motion made to adjourn at 8:35 pm EST by Karla, seconded by Terry. All in favor.

REGIONAL UPDATES

GREAT LAKES BELTED GALLOWAY ASSN

PRESIDENT - TERRY WILLIS (IL)

A total of 21 juniors representing 15 farms attended the event. Activities kicked off on Friday with educational clinics and contests. The showmanship clinic was led by Jaymie Tebbie, who provided valuable instruction on proper showmanship techniques and shared practical tips to help exhibitors present their cattle at their best. Following the clinic, juniors brought their own animals into the ring for hands-on practice and individualized instruction.

After a taco bar lunch, participants competed in the judging contest, where they evaluated two classes of heifers and two classes of steers. Once the contest concluded, Justin Stierwalt reviewed the official placings and explained the reasons behind each decision. Juniors who wished to practice oral reasons then presented to Justin, who offered constructive feedback and suggestions to improve their presentations. The Albaugh family treated everyone to a delicious pulled pork dinner before the juniors wrapped up the day with a game of touch football.

Saturday featured the Junior Showmanship Contest and Junior Show, both judged by Sue Schafer of Owaneco, Illinois. Sue did an outstanding job working with the exhibitors throughout the day. New this year was a Bred and Owned Bull Division for junior and senior bull calves. Bred and Owned female and male divisions were also featured. The day concluded with an All Other Breeds (AOB) Show, allowing juniors who exhibited Belted Galloways to also show cattle of another breed. The AOB show included one class of heifers and one class of steers.

Awards were presented following each show and contest, ensuring every junior received recognition. Each exhibitor also received a special participation bundle that included a boot bag donated by the Tebbie family, a Scotch comb, a rattle sorting paddle, a clipper blade box, a Scrubby Buddy comb, and a manure fork. The Albaugh family once again provided dinner, serving smoked brisket with all the fixings. Just as the meal concluded, a powerful storm moved through the fairgrounds, dropping 6½ inches of rain in only three hours. The heavy rainfall forced the evening soccer match indoors, where it was played in the show ring instead of outside.

The sun returned on Sunday as the weekend concluded with the Doug Abney Open Show. Hattie McGrady of Wingate, Indiana, judged the show and commented on the impressive depth and quality of the cattle exhibited throughout the event.

Begun in 2021 by the Southwest Belted Galloway Association and continued by the Great Lakes Belted Galloway Association, the American Royal is a historic highly respected livestock show that has been a cornerstone of the livestock industry for 127 Years.

KANSAS CITY, Kan. (April 23, 2026) – A new chapter for the American Royal will begin this fall as the organization welcomes competitors, exhibitors and the community to its new home in Kansas City, Kansas for the first time.

As part of this milestone, four of the American Royal's cornerstone events will be held at the new facility:

- The Royal Showcase Horse Show: September 12-13
- Cutting Horse Show: September 18-21
- World Series of Barbecue®: September 30-October 4
- Fall Livestock Show: October 9-25

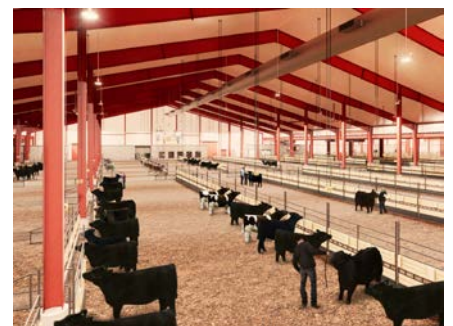
"This moment marks a meaningful step forward for the American Royal and the people who make it what it is," said Pat Macy, chief executive officer of the American Royal. "These events have such deep roots, and being able to bring them to our new home is something we've been working toward for a long time."

For the first time in its 127-year history, the American Royal will host events on a campus it owns. Construction on five livestock barns and an exhibition hall, which totals 390,000 square feet, is approximately 80% complete and on track for a September opening.

The new site, near 118th Street and State Avenue in Kansas City, Kansas, is being developed as a year-round destination for agriculture, education and events, bringing together competition spaces, educational programming and community experiences in one location.

Looking ahead, the campus will include an 80,000-square-foot learning and engagement center designed to tell the full story of American agriculture and food systems. The two-story center will feature a 750-seat amphitheater, nine interactive exhibit zones, cooking and culinary labs, and dedicated galleries celebrating the history and champions of the American Royal.

"Having a campus with this kind of scale and flexibility allows us to build on what the American Royal has become over the past 127 years," said Macy. "We're excited to begin this transition to our new home and start hosting events here this fall, even as development continues. This is the beginning of the American Royal's next chapter."

CALCULATING COSTS

OF BEEF PRODUCTION

Knowing the income and costs involved in your operation is the first step in determining how profitable your beef enterprise will be. One of the challenges, however, is that the costs of beef cattle enterprises are often specific for each operation. In addition, it can sometimes be difficult to know what costs should be attributed to the beef enterprise if the farm runs several different enterprises. For example, if you are trying to run separate cattle and cropping enterprises as one farm, do the hours you hire someone to spread manure get attributed to the cattle enterprise, or do they count as fertilizer and, thus, get attributed to the crop enterprise? The following article was written to help beef cattle producers assess their on-farm costs and determine how those costs apply to the beef cattle enterprise. This article is written for producers so that they might consider three broad categories – direct expenses, direct income, and hidden costs – and the items that may be attributed to each of those categories. This article is not intended to be an exhaustive list but rather should be used as a guidance tool for producers trying to better understand their finances.

DIRECT EXPENSES

The first broad category to consider for the beef production enterprise is direct expenses. As the name perhaps implies, items in the direct expenses category should include any cost that the beef farm incurs. Often the easiest thing to think about in this category is the purchase of outside feed, but do not neglect the other expenses relative to the beef enterprise that should be considered. Use the examples below to help guide your direct expense line items. Beef cattle enterprises can be one of the most unique farm enterprises. Many farms will not have all the examples listed, but there could also very well be other costs on the farm!

FEED AND HAY PURCHASED

This expense item should include any feed or hay purchased to feed or supplement the cattle on the farm. Check local hay auction markets for current prices. Shop around for feed at different mills. Alternatively, you may be able to buy feed and hay from one of your neighbors and work out better deals due to proximity.

FEED AND HAY RAISED

This expense item includes the cost to produce any feed or hay raised on the home farm. It is not always easy to calculate the cost to produce feed and hay for the cattle enterprise. Nonetheless, this production cost is critical.

In addition, one must consider what that feed would bring on the open market if sold because it could represent a lost opportunity cost at that point. Using hay as the example, look at your hay enterprise, realize what portion of that hay can be attributed to cattle production, and apply those costs to determine the “price” of the hay to the cattle enterprise. There is certainty in raising your own feed—you know exactly what you are getting because you produced it. But, if you make very good quality small square bales on your farm, for example, you may be dollars ahead to sell those small bales and purchase round bales of a more marginal quality because, in many cases, beef cattle can use poorer quality hay. Once you determine the costs, you can start playing with these scenarios more.

SUPPLIES

Supplies would include incidentals, such as feed buckets/hay feeders, waterers, fly control, fence repair, tools, et cetera, that are used for beef cattle production. While each item represents a minor cost on its own, supply costs can add up and overwhelm an operation if they are not recorded and managed.

REPAIRS

Repairs are any repairs to equipment that are specifically associated with the beef production enterprise. Tractors may be used for the beef enterprise, for example, but if they are not fully dedicated to the beef enterprise, the cost of those tractor repairs may need to be split between other farm enterprises. Other examples of repairs for the beef enterprise may include trucks, trailers, brush hogs, et cetera.

FERTILIZER, LIME, AND SPRAYS

The fertilizer, limes, and sprays category includes those consumable products that are applied to pastures, crops, or hay fields that are used to feed the beef cattle.

MACHINE HIRE

Machine hire would include any payment made towards the rental of a piece of equipment or the hiring of someone to come to the farm and do custom work. For example, hiring someone to bale hay would be a machine hire cost.

ANIMALS PURCHASED FOR RESALE (NOT BREEDING STOCK)

Animals purchased for resale may include feeder calves, or fat steers purchased for a freezer trade, as part of the beef production enterprise. The cost of these animals should be entered as an individual line item in the budget.

CALCULATING COSTS

OF BEEF PRODUCTION

INSURANCE

All farms should carry farm insurance to cover unexpected incidences as well as regular “maintenance” items.

Farm insurance should include liability and workmen’s compensation and may include any umbrella coverage, which includes excess liability coverage. In addition, insurance costs could include any health insurance for the owner/operator and any additional employees.

INTEREST ON LOANS

The interest on loans expense item includes any interest paid on loans specific to the beef enterprise. Loans specific to the beef enterprise could include the farm mortgage or equipment, cattle, and operating loans. Operating loans are sometimes referred to as a line of credit.

WAGES PAID

This expense item should include any wages for employees that directly facilitate the cattle operation. In addition, wages paid to the owner/operator SHOULD be included (more on that later).

TAXES

Taxes include fuel taxes and local, county, school, and any other property taxes associated with the operation. Keep in mind, taxes may be variable if crop or hay ground is in counties apart from where the beef herd is located and are owned and used for feed production for the beef operation.

VETERINARY AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES

Any time you call the veterinarian to the farm, there will be a cost associated with that. However, there are additional costs that fall into this category, including any drugs for disease prevention or vaccination of the cattle.

BREEDING COSTS

(SEMEN PURCHASED, REGISTRATION COSTS, AI SUPPLIES, ETC.)

Breeding costs include anything used in the operation to breed cows. Thus, breeding costs may include semen costs, synchronization drugs, artificial insemination (AI) supplies, and liquid N. In addition, remember to charge the cost of the breeder’s time in this category. If the farm is not using synchronized breeding and AI, the cost of the bull and any heat detection devices should be accounted for.

MARKETING COSTS

Marketing costs include advertising costs or commissions paid to the auction barn. Today, this may also include website design and maintenance for the farm’s online presence.

TRAVEL AND/OR FREIGHT COSTS

Consider how your products are getting to the market. If you are hauling cattle yourself, this includes depreciation on the truck, cost of gasoline, et cetera. If you are selling direct through the freezer trade, this will include the cost of getting animals to the butcher, even if you are hiring a hauler, so be sure to include that cost. If a commercial hauler is picking animals up at your place, to take them to a large packer, you will likely see freight costs deducted directly from your check. Make sure to account for it!

DIRECT INCOME

Items in the direct income category should be anything that the beef farm does that generates revenue. Most often the easiest thing to think about in this category is the sale of cattle themselves, but do not neglect the other aspects that should be considered. Use the examples provided to help guide direct income line items. Remember, beef cattle operations are unique and there may be other things that are generating income on the farm!

CASH PAID FOR ANYTHING SOLD BY THE CATTLE OPERATION

The cash paid income is straightforward. Any time you receive payment for cattle sold or feed sold, if you have only one enterprise, it should be included in this line item.

SERVICES PROVIDED

If you provide a service to another operation, it should be attributed as such. In a beef enterprise, services provided may include consulting, mowing pastures, breeding cattle, or hauling.

EMBRYOS, SEMEN SOLD

This item includes any income to the farm for embryos or semen that are sold off the farm. This may not be the first source of income for the farm, but it is a growing part of many beef enterprises.

HAY OR FEED SOLD

This category includes hay or feed raised on the home farm, or brokered, that is sold and provides income to the beef enterprise. This category is also only relevant if the farm is running one enterprise and does not separate out the cropping and beef enterprises.

CALCULATING COSTS

OF BEEF PRODUCTION

HIDDEN COSTS

Finally, in every operation there are hidden costs. These costs are sometimes also referred to as opportunity costs because they represent losses or inefficiencies in the system. These hidden costs can come in the form of inefficient equipment that breaks down or even just takes too long to get around the field; inadequate management, which can lead to a plethora of inefficiencies such as poor gain; and inadequate feed efficiency and reproductive issues, which can increase calving intervals and/or decrease the percent of calves born and weaned. One of the most overlooked hidden costs is the value of your time. Could you be doing something else with your time that would increase the income of the operation? Sometimes, increased income can be best realized by taking a job off the farm.

DETERMINING COSTS

If the farm is new, or you are attempting to develop a business case, or if you just want to know how your farm “stacks up,” it can be challenging to identify what the costs and income should be. In those instances, the Iowa Ag Decision Maker is a great tool to use because it allows you to do projections for a business plan or to determine future costs and income based on the projections. However, it is important to keep in mind that the Iowa Ag Decision Maker is based on midwestern prices, and production and farming costs can be regionally specific. For example, farm labor in one area may be just minimum wage and yet in another area it may be impossible to hire anyone for less than \$15 per hour. In many cases, when determining costs and making projections, it is best to put in the extra legwork. Ask neighboring farmers about their costs for feed or production. Consult feed and fertilizer dealers in your areas to determine supply costs. Ask about custom hire rates and availability in the area – custom rates may be cheaper than owning the equipment. Alternatively, you may be trying to hire someone to mow pastures for you only to find out there is not anyone other than the local landscaper. If that is the case, you will likely be paying landscape prices to do the job.

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS: ACCOUNTING METHODS

It is always a good idea to hire a professional familiar with farm accounting to assist you with setting up and developing accounting methods. Cash basis easily accounts for the income and expenses during the year, but cash basis does not consider accounts receivable and accounts payable that may be outstanding or unpaid, nor does it include balances on loans. The true financial health of a business is only

determined by utilizing the accrual method which allows for the inclusion of those items, expenses or income, that are anticipated but may not yet be in hand. Most agricultural accounts will use the cash basis for income tax reporting; but they may also use the accrual method to determine the true health of the business.

ENTERPRISE ACCOUNTING

Throughout the discussion, we have emphasized the beef enterprise and accounts relative to the beef enterprise. If all your farming operations are utilized by the beef operation, then you have a one-enterprise situation and all expenses can be assigned to that operation. However, if you have a beef operation and make hay that will be sold, then you may have two different enterprises and thus the need for enterprise accounting. Enterprise accounting allows you to assign costs and income of certain items based on their influence for a particular enterprise. A good example of this is a tractor. What percentage of time is that tractor used for haymaking versus feeding cows? Is the hay being made by that tractor being sold or used to feed the cows? All of this is necessary so that costs associated with that tractor are divided evenly among the two enterprises. If the tractor is only being used in the hay operation and the beef enterprise is buying hay from the hay enterprise, the entire cost of the tractor can be applied to the hay enterprise. This may seem confusing at first, but once you decide on how your operation is going to be accounted for it becomes much easier. Many cow/calf producers operate two or more enterprises. If that is the case, make sure each enterprise is bearing the brunt of the costs of production.

A professional who understands farms and is willing to assist you with determining how to set up your accounting system and how to accurately track income and expenses is an invaluable tool. They can help you determine the health of your business and assist you with making decisions on whether to expand or dissolve an enterprise. Starting the operation with the accounting system in mind and understanding what items need to be tracked from the beginning will make life much easier as your business grows. Good financial management will enable you to make sound decisions on purchases and expansion as time moves along.

- Demonstrate sportsmanship in all competitions and contests. I will be modest in winning and generous in defeat.
- Utilize teamwork to help others succeed.
- Cooperate in all programs and activities.
- Attend and be on time to meetings, events, and activities.
- Represent the National Belted Galloway Association, the Belted Galloway breed, the beef industry and the agriculture industry with pride.

Consequences of breaking the NJBGA Code of Conduct and any additional rules set forth at any NJBGA-sponsored event may include, but are not limited to, removal from the NJBGA Junior council as well as not being allowed to participate in future NJBGA-sponsored events and/or shows.

BGS Director of Junior Activities and the Executive Director have authority to determine consequences for conduct (listed and non-listed) deemed unacceptable.

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge I have read and understand the National Belted Galloway Association Code of Conduct and pledge to uphold the rules at each conference and event sponsored by the NJBGA/BGS. I am aware that the actions and decisions of both myself and others that violate these rules may result in the loss of privileges. In the event that these rules are broken or abused, I understand my parents and/or guardians will be notified.

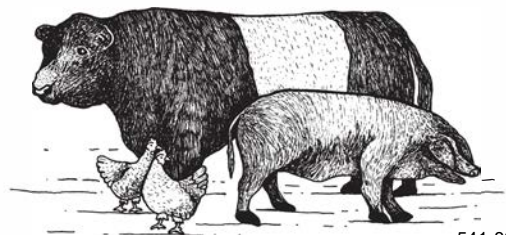

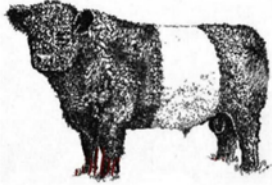

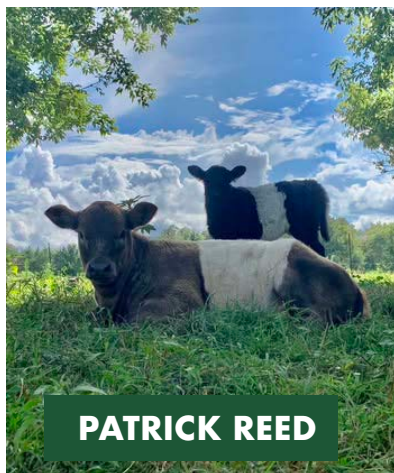
